Vladimir Ivanovich Shevtsov Academician Professor
MD, MS, PhD, DSc [Course Director]



Professor Vladimir Shevtsov is an honoured Scientist of the Russian Federation, a corresponding member of the Russian Academy of Medical Sciences and Academician of the Russian Academy of Medical and Technical Science. He is one of the first disciples of the world-known orthopaedic surgeon-academician G.A. Ilizarov. He has been General Director of the Russian Ilizarov Scientific Center for Restorative Traumatology and Orthopaedics (Kurgan, Russia). Professor Shevtsov has been working at the Faculty for training on the Ilizarov method from 1982, where he teaches more than 6,000 national and foreign specialists. He taught the study and application of the Ilizarov methods in many countries including USA, UK, Italy, Germany, Japan, South Korea, and so on. He serves as a member of many international societies and editorial boards and has received many international medals and awards for his scientific and clinical work on Ilizarov methods. He has more than 700 publications and published more than 40 books.

Md. Mofakhkharul Bari MD, MS, PhD
[Course Co-ordinator]



Professor Md. Mofakhkharul Bari is the chief consultant of Bari-Ilizarov Orthopaedic Centre, Dhaka, Bangladesh. He did his Ph.D. in Ortho and Reconstructive Surgery at Tashkent and Post-Doctoral fellowship from Kurgan. He is the Visiting and Honored Professor of Ilizarov Centre, Kurgan, Russia. He worked as a former Unit Chief, National Institute of Traumatology and Orthopaedic Rehabilitation (NITOR), Dhaka, Bangladesh. He has worked with world renowned Academician Professor V.I. Shevtsov, Kurgan. Prof. Bari is specialized in Complex trauma problems, limb lengthening, deformity correction and bone reconstructions. He has published 6 Books on Ilizarov technique that gained tremendous admiration from the relevant quarters. He has 118 publications of which 66 international & 52 are national publications. Dr. Bari is best known for his landmark research in the field of limb lengthening & deformity correction. He has presented over 146 lectures in international conferences in both Russian & English language.

Konstantin Novikov MD, MS, PhD, DSc
[Head of Cosmetic Orthopaedic Department]



Professor Novikov has been involved with the Ilizarov Centre for more than 35 years. He has more than 150 scientific publications, 40 inventions and more than 100 rationalization proposals. His dissertation was on "Surgical limb lengthening for patients with short and subjectively short stature by the Ilizarov method of transosseous osteosynthesis."

Natalia Shikhaleva MD, MS, PhD, DSc
[Head of Hand Surgery Department]



Professor Shikhaleva is one of the leading specialists in hand surgery of the Russian Federation. She has the most experience in the application of transosseous osteosynthesis in the pathology of the hand, where this method is widely combined with microsurgery and plastic surgery. Since January 2004 till present, she is the head of the Department of Hand Surgery at the Russian Ilizarov Scientific Center "Restorative Traumatology and Orthopaedics." She has prepared 5 medical technologies, 76 scientific publications of which 22 of them were the publications recommended by Higher Certification Commission; made 35 scientific reports on the regional and international conferences, developed 24 technical decisions made at the level of rationalization proposals, 2 inventions and 1 utility model.

Sergey S. Leonchuk MD, MS, PhD
[Head of Pediatric Orthopaedic Department]



Since January 2016, Professor Leonchuk has been the head of the 6th orthopaedic department at the Ilizarov Centre. His PhD was on "Treatment of congenital recurrent clubfoot in school age children by the Ilizarov method." He is the author and co-author of 20 scientific publications in Russian magazines - 4 in English and 1 manual for orthopaedic surgeons.
